



HOSPITALITY RIDER

Definitions

In this document, “Purchaser” refers to the entity hiring the band and hosting the performance, while “Performer” refers to the musical entertainment group, The M-80s.

The items listed in this rider are a guide to providing adequate preshow and post-show amenities in order to facilitate an excellent event. Substitutions must be approved and arranged prior to the day of the performance. Please contact Michael Weidenbach (205-913-3808) or Mike Tucker (205-572-6292) early and often with any questions.

Parking & Load-In

Purchaser will provide free, secure parking for 2-5 vehicles in proximity to the load-in door with a clear path from parking to stage. If free parking is not available, Purchaser agrees to provide payment for all parking fees prior to load-in.

Dressing Room

Purchaser will provide at least 1 clean, well-lit, lockable, temperature-controlled area as the Dressing Room to include the following furnishings and facilities:

- Seating for 8
- Full-length mirror and a hanging rack for clothes
- A minimum of 8 black hand towels
- Clean, private restroom
- Trash can

Hospitality

Purchaser will provide the following in the dressing room upon arrival. Brand substitutions must be cleared in advance.

- WiFi network ID and Password posted visibly
- An iced cooler containing:
 - One (1) case of bottled water
 - Where alcohol is allowed:
 - 1 12-pack of domestic light beer (Bud Light or Coors Light preferred)
 - 1 375ml bottle of Bombay Sapphire Gin
 - 1 375ml bottle Skyy Vodka



- 1 1-liter bottle of Tonic Water
- 1 6-pack of Coke Zero
- Healthy snacks e.g., assorted nuts, fruit, vegetable plate, etc.

Meals

If meals for the Performer are negotiated as part of total compensation, the following must be provided:

- Hot healthy meals for members of the band and crew. This number is usually 6 people in total.
- Vouchers for approved proprietary dining options are acceptable.
- A per-meal buyout option is available for \$300. This amount absolves all Purchaser responsibility for one meal for all band members.
- Menu, crew size, and other meal arrangements as described above must be discussed and approved by the Performer prior to the Performance Date.

Onstage Hospitality

Purchaser will provide 2 bottles of water for each band member to be located onstage just prior to the start of the show.

Guest List

For public events, Purchaser may receive a Guest List from the Performer prior to the Performance and will provide free admission at will call for up to 10 guests.

Merchandise

A dedicated area for the Performer's Merch Table will be provided to facilitate a post-show Meet & Greet and to sell merchandise. Purchaser will provide a 6' table, 2 chairs, and access to power. This should be in a secure area that is monitored by staff once the audience is admitted to the venue.

The M-80s are responsible for all required Sales Tax if a sales tax statement is provided. There will be no percentage split with the venue or any other entity of any merchandise sales. There will be no house fees, commissions, or surcharges of any kind. Purchaser will not interfere with Performer's POS systems.

Load-In and Load-Out

Load-in access will be granted at least 2 hours prior to sound check. Providing stagehands and dollies or hand trucks will facilitate this process and keep the event on schedule.



After the show, the venue will allow a half hour for the Performer to host a Meet & Greet and sell merchandise. The Performer will then change clothes and pack out stage gear and merchandise. The Purchaser will allow up to 2 hours for this entire post-show process, providing venue access, power, and lights.

Lodging

When lodging is contracted, The Performer requires 5 rooms (with double or king beds) per night in a hotel with a 3 out of 5-star rating on Yelp. Hotel should be located within a 15-minute drive of the venue in a safe neighborhood and must be approved by The Performer prior to booking. National chain hotels are preferred, examples of which include Holiday Inn Express, La Quinta, Courtyard by Marriott, and Best Western.

Hotel must provide a free breakfast and internet access. If the Purchaser chooses to provide lodging without breakfast, a \$120 breakfast buy-out must be provided.

Once reserved, Purchaser will provide all hotel and check-in details to the Performer at least 1 week prior to the Performance.

A lodging buyout option is available, with Performer determining the amount based on seasonal local rates.
